RESURRECTION EGGS

Open them Easter morning or the days leading up to Resurrection Sunday.

Here's a list of 12 items you can tuck inside plastic eggs that are part of the Holy Week story. If you don't have items at home, look for a substitute or come up with you own. There are suggested scriptures to read with each egg.

- 1. A palm leaf piece or picture of a donkey (Palm Sunday) John 12:12-15
- 2. A small cup (Last Supper). Matthew 26:26-28
- 3. A flower (the Garden where Jesus prayed) Matthew 26:36-39
- 4. Some coins (Judas' betrayal) Matthew 26:14-16
- 5. A piece of leather (the whip) Mark 15:15
- 6. A thorn (the crown of thorns) Matthew 27:29
- 7. A toothpick (the spear in Jesus' side) John 19:33-34
- 8. Dice (the soldiers who gambled for his clothes) John 19:23-24
- 9. A nail (crucifixion) John 19:18
- 10. A small piece of fabric (the linen cloth) Matthew 27:57-59
- 11. A rock (to cover the tomb) Matthew 27:59-60
- 12. An empty egg (to remember the tomb was empty) Matthew 28:6

Soap &/or small cloth (Jesus washed the feet of the disciples) John 13

Cracker (Last Supper). Matthew 26:26-28

A feather (for the rooster crowing at Peter's denial) Matthew 26:69-75

Cross (made of small sticks) Matthew 27:32-56
