R E S U R R E C T I O N R O L L S

A delicious Easter recipe to do with the kids! These simple rolls have marshmallows wrapped inside, which melt and become hollow as they bake. It represents the tomb of Jesus on Easter morning. When you break them open they are empty inside!

Large Marshmallows - Body of Jesus

Melted Butter - oils of embalming

Cinnamon and Sugar Mix - spices used to anoint the body of Jesus

Crescent Rolls - the wrappings of Jesus' body

Oven - the tomb

Cavity in the roll after baking - the empty tomb

Ingredients:

- 1 (10 ounce) can refrigerated crescent rolls
- 8 large marshmallows
- 1/4 cup melted butter (+ butter or spray to grease the baking sheet)
- 2 tablespoons cinnamon
- 2 tablespoons sugar

Directions:

- Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Lightly grease a baking sheet or muffin tin.
- Separate crescent rolls into individual triangles.
- In small bowl, mix together cinnamon and sugar.
- Dip a marshmallow into melted butter, then roll in sugar mixture. Place marshmallow in the center of the dough triangle. Carefully wrap the dough around the marshmallow. Pinch the seams together tightly to seal in the marshmallow as it melts in baking. Place on a baking sheet. Repeat for all eight rolls.
- Bake in a preheated oven until golden brown, about 15 minutes.
